High School Counselor (Academic & Personal Recommendations) 2. Minister, civic leader, or professional person (Character Recommendation)
Eligibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Applicant must be a male • Student must have a cumulative GPA of 2.80 or higher on a 4.0 scale. • Applicant’s permanent residence is in Waller County • Applicant has been admitted to Prairie View A&M University • Evidence of participation in leadership and community service activities
Selection Process	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Applicant Packets will be reviewed by the Education Committee <p>The scholarship will be awarded in the form of a check jointly written to the recipient and Prairie View A&M University.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Scholarship recipients will be notified by letter no later than June 30 of the scholarship year and will be requested to attend a Chapter meeting or event to receive recognition from the Chapter.
Award Process	<p>The scholarship recipient will provide a written request which shall include the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Admissions Letter of Admission to Prairie View A&M University – Degree being pursued and area of study/major – Name and address to which payment should be sent – A copy of the tuition receipt or other documentation verifying enrollment. <p>Upon approval of the Scholarship Committee, the Treasurer will mail a check to the scholarship recipient or to Prairie View A&M University</p>
